


# Product Overview

## Flat Graphite Bursting Disks **Series G2**



### Description

Series G2 safety Bursting Disks are flat Graphite Bursting Disks for low to medium burst pressures. Graphite Bursting Disks feature excellent corrosion resistance, thus are suitable for a variety of applications.


Series G2 Bursting Disks are used with HG2 holders. If necessary, they can also be combined with vacuum supports so the Bursting Disks can tolerate the full vacuum in vacuum direction even if in pressure direction they already open at pressures below 1.6 bar (g).

### HG2 Holder

Series G2 Graphite Bursting Disk must be placed inside HG2 Holder to ensure proper use. The Holder is available in graphite, stainless steel 1.4571 or special materials such as Hastelloy, and PTFE-lined – depending on the application requirements.




# Monobloc Graphite Bursting Disks Series G3

## Description

Series G3 safety Bursting Disks are Monobloc Bursting Disks. They are mounted directly between flanges, no special holder is required. The advantages of graphite Bursting Disks are their high corrosion resistance and the good cost/performance ratio in addition to their easy installation.

## Options G3M / G3MV / G3A / G3AV





Monobloc Bursting Disks are divided into two groups. The classic Bursting Disks **G3M** and **G3MV** (V...with Vacuum Support) made entirely from graphite, and the steel/stainless steel reinforced Bursting Disks **G3A** and **G3AV**. (A...Armoured, V...Vacuum Support). These are also installed directly between the flanges. The reinforcement ring absorbs the increased axial forces during installation which may occur due to flange tilting or misalignment.



### Burst Indicators


All STRIKO Burst Indicators are compatible with graphite or metal Bursting Disks, including Bursting Disks from other manufacturers, as well as Safety Valves. For every application the right type – ask us, we're here to help!

Model	Description
SVT 02	The standard Burst Indicator – for monitoring Bursting Disks (detects opening of Bursting Disks and Safety Valves)
SVT 05	The Leakage Sensor – detects smallest volume flows (leaking Safety Valves or Bursting Disks damaged by pitting corrosion / hairline fractures)
SVT AM	The full metal alarm device– for high temperatures and aggressive mediums
SVT AM-L	The low pressure alarm device – for minimal differential pressures starting from 10mbar



### HG2 Holder

The HG2 Holder is required for series G2 flat graphite Bursting Disks. It's available in various materials, e.g. graphite, stainless steel 1.4571, PTFE-lined or in the special material Hastelloy C276, depending on customer requests and the application.



## Applications and Advantages:

Graphite Bursting Disks are especially recommended for:

1. Applications with aggressive mediums as graphite is very corrosion-resistant
2. as an alternative to more costly Bursting Disks made of special metal materials such as Hastelloy, silver or tantalum.
3. for systems where over- or under-pressures occur frequently based on the process, since this type of safety device is effective and inexpensive compared to a Safety Valve, yet offers very high tightness to the bursting point.
